

1st DEP ACADEMY: 20th - 30th June 2017

SEERC and i4G - Thessaloniki, Greece



The Thessaloniki Academy in Urban Solutions was hosted in City College, International Faculty of the University of Sheffield in Thessaloniki, Greece.

FOCUS

Solving contemporary urban problems (e.g. aging population, environmental regulations, transportation, refugees, etc.) with state-of-the-art technologies (gamification, AI, VR, data analytics, etc.).

PROGRAM

The structure was based on interactive lectures, teamwork and mentoring. The program was designed to guide the participants through the lean startup process (from ideation, to validation, to pivoting and pitching), as well as to offer participants stimuli on the thematic domain of Urban Solutions. This valuable integration was deployed by actively engaging not only professional startup mentors, but also a startup offering city guide services. All teams worked with specific tools (e.g. business model canvas, budget, idea deck) and presented their idea and team in front of an expert panel in the last day of the academy.
